Covid restrictions

Unfortunately, after the Easter Hat parade we had several parents and students, as well as a Principal who tested positive to Covid. This shows the importance of following our Covid guidelines, social distance and continue healthy hygiene habits. Our next school event will be the Sausage sizzle and canteen operating at our School Cross Country on Friday 13th May. I need all parents to follow our Covid safe procedures carefully. Parents cannot mingle with students or other parents. They need to maintain social distances and sit on the other side of the oval. Although masks are not mandatory, it may be wise.

Covid restrictions & updates

Last term, like most schools across the State we had an increase in the rate of students and parents infected by Covid. There are grave concerns that with winter approaching the spread of Covid will increase across our school. To restrict the spread of covid in our school we are maintaining restrictions for the next 4-6 weeks. We are still limiting the number of parents coming on site, continuing staggered pick-up times. It's about keeping our students, staff and families safe.

It is vital you check your child for symptoms and even if they have the slightest symptoms, please do a test. If they test positive, please contact NSW Health, and then contact the school. Students will then need to isolate for 7 days or until they have no symptoms thereafter. If your child shows signs of covid at school we will call for you to come and collect them.

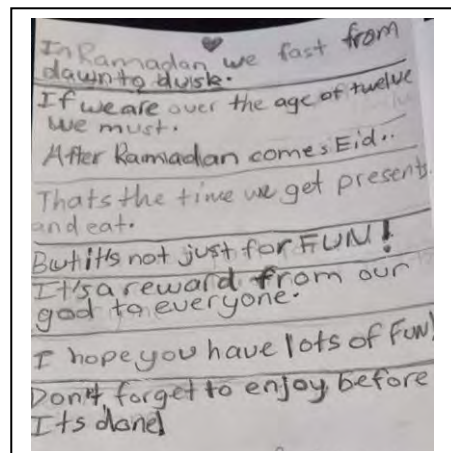
Eid

The name "Eid al-Fitr" translates as "the festival of the breaking of the fast".

It's a tradition to wear new clothes and on the way to the mosque, to eat something sweet, such as a date, and recite a short prayer, called a takbeer. Important Health & Safety messages

Sharing Food.

It is very important that all children only eat the food their parents have provided for them. Students are not to share food with other students, especially during Covid. Students must not touch other students' food as well. Some students have severe allergies, and a small touch of certain foods can cause a major reaction. Please discuss this matter with your children to ensure they only eat their food.

Crossing Annangrove Road

Every afternoon I do bus duty. I will not let your child go outside the gate until they can see you, especially our younger students. However, I need your cooperation. Please collect your child and move away from the area. Please keep a covid safe distance. Please DO NOT walk down the road a little bit and then cross Annangrove Road. I saw parents and students doing this last week. This is very dangerous. The only place to cross Annangrove Road is at the traffic lights.

Parking in the Church carpark

Our parents and grandparents are very lucky to have access to the Zorro Church turning circle. This makes it much easier to collect your children and then turn legally into the church grounds to do a U-turn, before heading home. I have had several reports this week of cars belonging to parents and grandparents of our students parking in the turning circle. It is **not** a parking spot. It can only be used as a turning circle.

Envelopes need to be returned to school

Please **do not** use the school online parent portal to pay for the photographs.

- The school **does not** process any payments on behalf of the company, we just collect the envelopes.
- All envelopes need to be returned to school prior to photo day.
- If you have decided you would like a sibling photograph please complete the separate envelope.

Payment needs to be made online directly to 'the school photographer' website (follow step by step instructions on the envelope). Or return the exact cash payment in the envelope. (The office does **not** open the envelopes and is **unable** to provide change). Thank you for your understanding.



Road Safety

School Parking

Our students, staff and parents are always on the lookout for drivers driving illegally around the school. I have had several reports of parents parking in the bus zones. The bus zone is always a bus zone. If you park across the road in front of the school, please ensure you and your child cross at the lights. Do NOT run across Annangrove Road. This is very dangerous and sets a bad example for your child and the other children at our school. Please look closely at the updated rules and fines shown on the sheet from the RTA.

Road & Pedestrian safety.

This is friendly and timely reminder of the road rules, particularly with a few recent tragic accidents that have occurred down the road from our school.

X No U-turns anywhere in a school zone.

X No parking in the bus zone.



Use the crossing: if you park on the other side of the road please do not dart across the road. Dashing between cars, hovering on white lines, dodging cars is an accident waiting to happen. Please take a minute to walk up to the crossing and cross safely.




Once at the crossing make absolutely sure cars have stopped before you proceed to cross. Annangrove Road is a fast road (70km/h) and some people forget to slow down in the school zone (40km/h). Be aware at all times.

If after drop off or pick up you need to turn around to head back towards Rouse Hill there are 3 options:

1. Drive just past the crossing, and on the right-hand side of the road at No. 196 Annangrove Road (Australian Zoroastrian Association) you will see a horseshoe shaped driveway. We have permission from the church to use this driveway to safely turn. However, we do not have permission to park in their grounds so please respect their request to not do so.

2. You can drive up to Deborah Road, turn left and ensure you make a safe turn; or

3. If you are heading in the other direction continue out of the school zone and turn into Woodland Road (on the right) and once passed the double lines you can turn safely around.

-  Please do not park over any of our neighbours' driveways and take care when walking across driveways.
-   To avoid parking congestion consider parking up at Annangrove Park and walk to school, collect a coffee on the way or have a play in the park or take a look at the community street library on the way home. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our school community and local area safe!

Health & Wellbeing

Keeping our students safe at school

Adults must practise social distancing at all times when around the school grounds.

All students need to bring a water bottle from home to fill at school rather than drink from water bubblers by mouth.

We will be continuing our good hygiene practices such as:

1. Regularly washing hands with soap
2. Hand sanitiser is available for students to use
3. Avoid sharing drinks and food
4. Coughing or sneezing into your elbow
5. Throw tissues in the bin after being used

If your child is sick or unwell, please keep them at home to rest and recover. Students should be at school unless:

- they have returned a positive RATS test
- they have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition and the expected timeframe
- they are currently unwell.

In accordance with advice from NSW Health, parents and carers are reminded **NOT** to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms. Schools will make arrangements for students who present as unwell or have flu-like symptoms to be sent home.

NSW Health have requested that schools encourage anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms, to arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the [COVID-19 clinics](#)
